

Fall Midweek Program – October 11-November 15

Midweek will start on Wednesday, October 11, and go for 6 weeks. There will be a meal at 6:00 each Wednesday and classes from 6:45-7:45 p.m. Below is information on the book study being offered. If you would like to participate in this book study, please sign up on the back bulletin board so enough books will be available. This will be a facilitated discussion of the book led by Pastor Verle so please read at least the first two Chapters before the first night of Midweek. The study will be in the large classroom on the education side of the church (the old youth room).



Have you ever been afraid to question your beliefs and the beliefs of others? Would you like to be able to honestly discuss those questions with those who are followers of Jesus? If so, the Midweek study, starting October 11, is for you. We will tackle the book, BENEFIT OF THE DOUBT, by Greg Boyd, theologian and pastor at Woodland Hills Church, St Paul, MN.

In this book, Greg wrestles with the common perception that asking questions of the faith is dangerous. Looking at the people of the Bible, he claims that the ones that God approves of are those who are willing to engage with God and ask the hard questions.

I encourage you to participate in this book study. We will take each of the three parts of the book-- False Faith, True Faith, and Exercising Faith—and spend two sessions each on them.

Below is an excerpt from a review of Greg's book:

Gregory Boyd's *Benefit of the Doubt* is an intriguing look at the role of doubt in the life of faith. Boyd gives us a hefty dose of original thinking and a helpful critique of the evangelical world that is long overdue. ... Boyd's book is recommended reading for anyone who has intellectual questions about Christianity and struggles with doubt...

Boyd also has an interesting critique of the way many evangelicals believe doctrine. He calls it a "house of cards" faith in which all of the doctrines go together as one package. If one doctrine is taken out, or even doubted, the whole house of cards crumbles. Boyd relates the story of his own struggles understanding certain Bible passages or how faith and science go together, and how he lost his faith several times since he thought that he had to believe *every* doctrine proffered in order to be a Christian.

WHO'S YOUR HERO? September 17, 2017

Scripture:

Matthew 5:17-18; Mark 1:12-13; Romans 5:12-14

Summary:

Last Sunday we saw that God in his efforts to restore the broken relationship with his image bearers, became human in Jesus. We saw that this helps us to know that we are valued and loved by the God who created us. What we didn't dwell on was how God becoming man address our brokenness. Today I want to look at a statement that Jesus makes in the Sermon on the Mount. "I have come to fulfill the Law and the Prophets...until everything is accomplished." Paul in Romans 5 indicates that in some way there is a connection between Adam and Christ. In exploring this we will dig into the concept of "Corporate Solidarity."



Questions for Reflection and Discussion:

- 1. Who have been some of your heroes? What difference did they make in your life?
- 2. When have you experienced the sense of accomplishment through another person's actions?
- 3. In what way have you accessed the salvation that God has for you in Jesus?
- 4. What does it mean to be a follower of Jesus? How does that change your life?
