Ash Wednesday – February 17: Prayer Walk 11am-6pm

Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent and marks 40 days until Easter, excluding Sundays. This first day of Lent reminds us that new life with Christ involves a daily

surrendering of the old life and the first step on this Lenten journey invites us to acknowledge our mortality and our sinfulness by the imposition of ashes.

<u>For the practice of Ash Wednesday this year, there will be a prayer walk at the church</u>. There will be a progression of prayer stations set up in the church for individuals or families to come to at their convenience and walk through the prayer stations with a station set up at the end to make the sign of the cross upon your forehead with ashes. The church will be unlocked from 11am-6pm on Ash Wednesday, February 17th. We invite all to participate as we begin our journey through Lent.
