My Coins Count offering will go to MCC at the Ohio Mennonite Relief Sale in August for water projects sponsored by MCC to help provide clean drinking water and new wells for communities all over the world. Water is Life!

- The task of collecting water tends to fall on women, and children between the ages of eight and 13.
- As a result, women are often unable to get jobs or contribute financially to their households. Children are often unable to go to school or get an education due to the thousands of hours they have to spend annually just hauling water.
- The average distance that someone in a developing community walks to fetch water is 3.75 miles.
- **♦ When you fill a 5-gallon jug with water, it weighs 44 pounds.**
