<u>March 6th.</u> Sunday School quarterlies for the summer quarter will be ordered the end of March.



Ash Wednesday Service – March 2 @ 7:00 p.m.

Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent and marks 40 days until Easter, excluding Sundays. This first day of Lent reminds us that new life with Christ involves a daily surrendering of the old life and
