

- ALL: and follow Your way more faithfully.





- Pray for peace and justice throughout the world; we pray for the situation between Ukraine and Russia. We pray against the spirit of violence and war and pray for peace in the area.




Coffee Time & Fellowship @ Church – Sunday mornings
