My Coins Count offering goes to MCC (Mennonite Committee Central) at the Ohio Mennonite Relief Sale on July 7-8 @ the Mt. Hope Event Center. With your support, MCC works with local partners to make sure people have access to clean water closer to their homes, both today and in the future.

In 2020, 5.8 billion people used safely managed drinking-water services – that is, they used improved water sources located on premises, available when needed, and free from contamination <u>Drinking-water (who.int)</u>. The remaining 2 billion people without safely managed services in 2020 included:

- ➤ 1.2 billion people with basic services, meaning an improved water source located within a round trip of 30 minutes;
- > 282 million people with limited services, or an improved water source requiring more than 30 minutes to collect water;
- > 368 million people taking water from unprotected wells and springs; and
- > 122 million people collecting untreated surface water from lakes, ponds, rivers & streams.

Help provide water, the gift of life! Ways to give:

- Mark your offering envelope "My Coins Count"
- Take a mission bank home and start collecting your change (banks are by the mailboxes).
- Drop your change in the wishing well in the church lobby.

Maple Grove has an offer of matching funds for My Coins Count up to \$20,000. For every dollar donated, it will be matched dollar-for-dollar up to \$20,000. So if the church can raise \$20,000 – we'll have \$40,000 to give to MCC at the Relief Sale!
