



My Coins Count offering goes to MCC (Mennonite Committee Central) at the Ohio Mennonite Relief Sale on July 7-8 @ the Mt. Hope Event Center. With your support, MCC works with local partners to make sure people have access to clean water closer to their homes, both today and in the future.

- 1 in 3 healthcare facilities does not have access to hand hygiene where care is provided.
- Almost 2 billion people depend on health care facilities without basic water services.
- Timely hand hygiene prevents up to 50% of avoidable infections acquired during health care delivery, including those affecting the health workforce. (WHO/UNICEF 2021)
