

Notebooks and pencils are treasures for families around the world who have been forced to flee their homes or struggle to afford basic school supplies. Without these items, many kids in places like Syria, Ukraine and South Sudan can't get the education they desperately need.

MCC is having a challenge for 10,000 school kits to be donated during the month of August. The Jr. Youth & Children's Sunday School classes are excited to take on this challenge and need your help! Below is a list of the items needed in each school kit – please bring new items only. If you would like to help with this project, you may start bringing items to church now as the Sunday School classes will work on this project each Sunday this summer - final day to send donations is August 13. MCC School Kit Items (new items only) – copies of this list available by the mailboxes:

- > 4 spiral or perforated-pages notebooks (8.5 in x 10.5 in and 70 sheets)
- > 8 new unsharpened pencils
- > 1 ruler (flat, good quality; must indicate 30 cm; inch markings optional)
- > 12 colored pencils (in packaging)
- > 1 large eraser
- > 4 new black or blue ballpoint pens
- 1 small all-metal pencil sharpener, one or two holes. (All-metal sharpeners can be found online at Amazon.com or in the art supply section of retail office supply stores.)
