<u>Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday</u>. Palm Sunday observes Jesus's triumphant and joyful entrance into Jerusalem, marked by jubilant crowds waving palm branches, which symbolize victory over sin, peace, and eternal life.

<u>On Maundy Thursday</u>, we will celebrate communion together as well as demonstrate our commitment to a servant's life by washing feet. A light meal will be served at 6:30 p.m. with the service following immediately after the meal.

We invite all believers to come to this service, giving thanks for Christ's life, death, resurrection and the gift of Salvation. We encourage you to prepare your hearts for this time.

<u>For Good Friday</u>, Pastor Nathanael has made devotions available as a guide to commemorate Jesus' suffering and death on the cross with prayer and meditation.

The devotions are available on the round table in the church lobby.

<u>Our Easter Sunday Celebration</u> will begin with sharing breakfast together at 8:30 followed by worshipping together at 10:00 a.m. There will not be Sunday School classes.


Join us Sunday mornings before Sunday School – Everyone is welcome!
